DATA ENTRY & CHANGES TO YOUR INFORMATION

Data entry mistakes happen. Please READ your preliminary and final confirmation notices. Most entries, dog and owner/handler information remains the same. However, if you have a:

- New email address
- New title
- New handler
- New address and phone
- New jump height (jump height can change from trial to trial.)

Highlighting ANY of these changes on entry forms would be especially helpful so that these changes can be updated in our database. Then, please review your confirmations carefully to ensure that your requested changes have been made.

LEASH RULE- EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2009

Chapter 4, Section 10 . Leashes new paragraphs 2 and 3- to require that dogs be on leash when entering and exiting the ring and to require that all clubs provide a holder or container where the leash is placed while the dog is running the course. The new paragraphs read as follows:

Chapter 4, Section 10. Leashes new paragraphs 2 and 3

Dogs must enter and exit the ring with the leash attached to the dog's collar or harness, or in the case of a slip lead, with the noose completely around the dog's neck, with the other end of the leash held by the handler. Any entry or exit chutes added to the ring for the ease of getting dogs in and out of the ring are not considered to be part of the ring.

Clubs must provide a leash holder or a container for the leash runner to place the leash in or on, which can easily be located by the handler near the ring exit. Leashes or slip leads may not be hung on the ring barrier nor placed on the ground.

Chapter 5, Section 4.e. Failure to Control- This section was eliminated to remove the option of dogs being under only verbal control when leaving the ring.

Chapter 5, Section 6. Mandatory Excusals- to require for the mandatory excusal of any dog whose owner violates the regulation in Chapter 4, Section 10

Chapter 5, Section 6 Mandatory Excusals

15. Any dog that does not enter or exit the ring on leash. On leash is defined as having the leash attached to the dog's collar or harness, or in the case of a slip lead, having the noose completely around the dog's neck.

PLEASE DON'T LOSE YOUR QUALIFYING RUN BY IGNORING THIS RULE!!!

ONLINE ENTRIES

Exhibitors are expected to maintain their premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner. Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at all motels.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a packed dirt surface, (climate controlled). Ring size will be a minimum of 100' x 120'.

24" weaves will be used.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulation it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

NEW SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

NEW ENTRY FORM: The new entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

AVMA Health Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- **Crating space** is plentiful on dirt floor. Mats are allowed and encouraged.
- **Seating** (bleachers) are provided by the facility, but exhibitors may wish to bring their own comfortable chair.
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, PBOTC and the Horseshoe Arena will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- Please keep your crating and parking areas clean.
- Use reduced speeds as you drive through the complex.
- **Please use designated exercise areas and clean up after your dog(s).** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- **Food concession** is available on the site but various restaurants and fast food vendors are available within a very short driving distance. No outside food or drink is allowed in the building.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Walk-throughs are scheduled at the discretion of the judges and the walkthrough schedule will be posted at the ring gate prior to the beginning of classes.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue
 Second Place..... Red
 Third Place..... Yellow
 Fourth PlaceWhite
 Qualifying Score Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. Dog and handler teams attaining their MACH or PAX title will receive a rosette and decorated bar. A plush dog toy (\$2.00 approx. value) will be awarded to all dogs receiving a first place ribbon. All awards must be claimed the day of the trial – no awards will be mailed.

Please remember to check the No Signature Required box *AND* sign that spot where you authorize them to deliver on any overnight package. Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Inquiries may be directed to Dana Rose at tributelabs@suddenlink.net.

Entries close on Saturday, Aug 21, 2010 at 11 PM DST. All entries must be submitted on an official AKC entry form including front and back of the form, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front and back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and agreement on the back of the entry form. Entries must be complete and legible. Credit cards will not be accepted. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT/CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY will be mailed or e-mailed to exhibitors at the ground or e-mail address provided on the entry form and should be received no later than three days prior to the trial date. Should the exhibitor NOT receive such acknowledgement within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary.

If an email address is provided, email notification of your entry status will be sent prior to closing as entries are processed.

If an email address is provided, confirmations & judging schedules will be sent via email after closing. Confirmations & judging schedules will only be mailed to those who did not provide an email address or the email address is not valid.

If an email address is provided, email notification of your move-up will be sent prior to closing as move-ups are processed. If you do not receive an email confirmation of your move-up, please verify receipt of your move-up with the trial secretary

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. PBOTC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or

property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. PBOTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the PBOTC or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

Full Refund of entry may be requested by an exhibitor via written notification prior to closing date/time.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, PBOTC will refund entry fees minus a \$5.00 handling fee per day for a bitch that comes into season after the closing date. Requests for refunds must be submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging and must be accompanied by a veterinary note.

Exhibitors are responsible for presenting a correct entry form. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of an entry form error committed by the owner/exhibitor. It is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor to provide correct and valid information and to enter their dog(s) in the proper jump height division. Corrections to entry forms and/or cancellations of entries will be accepted by the Trial Secretary prior to the published closing date/time.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive at ringside any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. In the case of a ring conflict, please notify the gate steward prior to the start of the class.
