From Dallas/Ft. Worth, San Angelo, Abilene:

Take I-20 West to Midland, exit at Garden City/San Angelo (Hwy 158) (Exit 138)
Turn right at I-20 Frontage and travel 0.6 miles
Look for black and red AST sign on left.

From El Paso:

Take I-20 East to exit at Garden City/San Angelo (Hwy 158) (Exit 138)
Turn left at TX-158 BUS (underpass)
Turn right at I-20 Frontage and travel 0.6 miles
Look for black and red AST sign on left.

From Lubbock:

Take 349 South to the north side frontage road of I-20 (Left turn before Interstate 20 underpass) Travel 0.6 miles. Look for black and red AST sign on left.

From Midland County Horseshoe Arena

Head east on I-20 Frontage four miles
Look for black and red AST sign on left.

(Safety Precaution: Obey all “Yield” signs for oncoming traffic coming from the Interstate.)

• Attention Exhibitors •

AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 11, states: Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. No puppies under six months of age will be allowed within the event precincts.

A Recording Fee of .50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of 3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Event. These fees are to be collected by the event giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the event, the Recording Fee is to be collected on both entries. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

NO overnight crating of dogs will be allowed at the event site. There will be no security on-site during non-event hours. PBOTC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the event - none will be mailed.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The trial secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of PBOTC or the Trial Secretary. The event giving Club, their agents, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email (with a reply from secretary to assure email was received) prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. An administrative fee will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

Enter your email address on the entry form if you would like to be notified before the Judging Program is mailed that the Trial Secretary received your entry.

RABIES ALERT: The State of Texas is under a statewide rabies quarantine. Proof of vaccination may be required.

AVMA Health Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
